

# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSON PROGRAM

The Marist-Sion College Instrumental Music Lesson Program that is an extra-curricular program offers students an opportunity to develop their musical, social, and personal awareness whilst learning a musical instrument.

Students learning a musical instrument are able to participate as part of a College ensemble for liturgies, masses, and concerts / events where they will gain valuable experience in performing in front of both their peers and the wider College Community.

## COMMITMENT

Our College Instrumental Music Lesson Program provides your child with an opportunity to learn from a Professional Music Instructor with the convenience of learning during the school day. To ensure your child is able to gain maximum experience, our College requires both the student and parent/carer/guardian to fully commit to learning the instrument.

An **Instrumental Music Lesson Agreement** form is to be completed and signed by the student and parent / guardian / carer prior to commencing the music lessons. If a student wishes to cease their music lessons, this will only be approved at the end of the Term, unless special circumstances apply by completing an **Instrumental Music Lesson Cancellation Form**.

Our College Instrumental Music Instructors will provide information, twice per Term, to the student and parent/carer/guardian in relation to the student's progress and performance.

## **MUSIC LESSONS**

The Instrumental Music Lesson Program allows students to participate in weekly lessons, either individually or in small groups that are instructed by one of our professional College Instrumental Music Instructors.

The music lessons are for 30 minutes during the school day each week and are timetabled on a two week rotating basis to minimise disruption to the student's school day. Student attendance will be taken and recorded in SIMON by the Instrumental Music Instructor.

A student music lesson will be rescheduled, where possible, if:

- A student is absent from the College on the day of the music lesson;
- A student is required to attend a College excursion, incursion or camp;
- The Instrumental Music Instructor is absent on the day of the music lesson;
- The music lesson is scheduled on a Student Free Day;
- The music lesson is scheduled on a Public Holiday.

If a student does not attend a scheduled music lesson for reasons than those above, the music lesson will not be rescheduled and the cost of \$35.00, inclusive of GST will be invoiced and noted as "Non Attendance."

## **COST PER LESSON**

The cost is **\$35.00 per lesson** (inclusive of GST) and will be invoiced each Term to the parent / guardian / carer by the College Fees Team.

The Learning Leader – Music Performance will provide information to the College Fees Team in relation to student attendance for each Term.

## **INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC EQUIPMENT HIRE**

Brass and Woodwind Instruments are available to hire from our College, at a cost, to support students with lessons / practice outside of their music lessons within the Instrumental Music Lesson Program and their scheduled music classes within the curriculum.

An **Instrumental Hire Agreement Form** is to be completed and signed by the student and parent / guardian / carer prior to a student being issued with an instrument for their use.
