ABOUT

The Marist-Sion College Instrumental Music Lesson Program is an extra-curricular program which offers students an opportunity to develop their musical, social, and personal awareness whilst learning a musical instrument.

Students learning a musical instrument are encouraged to participate in College ensembles, liturgies, masses, and concerts / events where they will gain valuable experience performing in front of both their peers and the wider College Community.

COMMITMENT

Our College Instrumental Music Lesson Program provides students with an opportunity to learn from a Professional Instrumental Music Instructor with the convenience of learning during the school day. To ensure your child can maximise their experience, our College requires both the student and parent/carer/guardian to fully commit to supporting their learning.

An **Instrumental Music Lesson Agreement** form, available below, is to be completed and returned by the student and parent / guardian / carer prior to commencing music lessons. Our College Instrumental Music Instructors will provide semester reports to parent/carer/guardian in relation to the student's progress and performance.

LESSON STRUCTURE

The Instrumental Music Lesson Program allows students to participate in weekly lessons, either individually or in small groups that are instructed by one of our College's Instrumental Music Instructors.

Music lessons run for 30 minutes during the school day each week and are timetabled on a rotating basis to minimise disruption to the student's school day. Student attendance will be taken and recorded in SIMON by the Instrumental Music Instructor.

Student's music lessons will be rescheduled, where possible, if:

- A student is required to attend whole College directed events such as mass and / or year-level camps;
- The Instrumental Music Instructor is absent on the day of the music lesson;
- The music lesson is scheduled on a Student Free Day;
- The music lesson is scheduled on a Public Holiday.

If a student does not attend a scheduled music lesson for reasons than those above, the music lesson will not be rescheduled or refunded.

COST

All prices are per lesson, per student (inclusive of GST).

Invoices are administered at the beginning of each Term to the parent / guardian / carer by the College Fees Team and are payable in full prior to the commencement of the following Term. *Please note: This rate is subject to review and may be adjusted annually.*

Instrumental Music Lesson Agreement – Student Terms and Conditions

- I agree to attend my scheduled lessons and arrive within the first 5 minutes.
- I am responsible for staying up to date with classwork when missing classes for lessons.
- I will bring all required materials, including my instrument, unless provided by the College.
- I will engage in my lessons respectfully and responsibly.
- Efforts will be made to reschedule lessons when impacted by College directed events, student free days or public holidays, or my Instrumental Music Instructor is absent.
- If I miss 2 or more lessons in a term that my parent/carer/guardian will be notified, and I will discuss solutions with the Performing Arts Department.
- I may be invited to participate in College music ensembles and performances.
- If undertaking VCE Music, I will inform my instructor about the performance and class requirements of this subject.
- If I do not own an instrument for VCE Music, I will discuss hiring or purchasing options with the Learning Leader for Music Performance.
- I understand that the College may cancel my lessons due to behavioural, academic, or safety concerns.
- If I wish to cancel lessons, I will complete an **Instrumental Music Lesson Agreement Cancellation** form and return it to the College.
